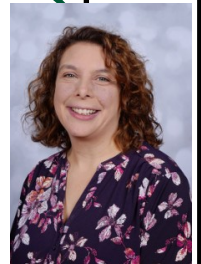

## Welcome

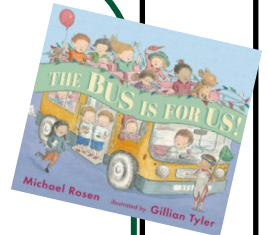

## Curriculum

This half term, our topic is '**Journey's**'. Through the term, we will be sharing high quality texts such as 'The journey home from Grandpa's' By Jemima Lumney and 'The Bus is for us! By Michael Rosen. These texts will support children learning new vocabulary and develop their comprehension through story discussion. Children will be developing their physical skills to support hand strength and core strength and stability. This will be supported in PE sessions in the hall led by Wyre Forest Sports Partnership. Children will develop their Mathematical skills reciting numbers in order and counting objects one at a time, finding ways to be efficient and accurate such as putting objects in 'line style'. Children will find out about the world around them, taking notice and describing different types of the weather they experience.

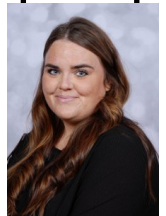
